## The Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) General Liability Insurance Requirements

Licensee shall obtain and maintain in force during the License Period the following insurance coverage:

a) not less than \$2,000,000 (per occurrence) inclusive limits for bodily injury to, death of or property damage to third parties, and such policies of insurance shall include RCM.; its Board of Governors employees and agents as a named insured and shall contain a cross liability clause; and

b) not less than \$2,000,000 for loss or damage to the property of RCM, in, on or about the Venue.

Five days prior to the Event, Licensee shall deliver to the RCM (<a href="mailto:music.fair@rcmusic.ca">music.fair@rcmusic.ca</a>), written evidence of insurance, in the form of a certificate or certified copy of an insurance policy issued by the insurer, which identifies the RCM as a named insured in the following manner:

THE ROYAL CONSERVATORY OF MUSIC, ITS BOARD OF GOVERNORS, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS and the written evidence shall contain an undertaking by the insurer not to cancel or limit the insurance overage so described except upon 5 days' prior written notice delivered to the RCM.

Please note that proof of insurance must be received by the RCM <u>5 days prior</u> to the Event date.
