

THE BASICS

Entering Notes:

To add a note, click a drum at left or Synth/Guitar at top right, then click a space in the circle in the yellow layer.

To delete a note, click it several times. To make a drum louder, click it once or twice. To make a synth or guitar longer, click it one or more times. Click/hold/scroll a synth/guitar note to change pitch.



This button clears the circle.



Press the Play button in the middle of the circle. Press again to stop.



Each note you enter is duplicated across a horizontal or vertical mirror line.

Rhythm Polygon

This button connects notes inside the circle to reveal hidden shapes.

BASS / SNARE +90

HI-HAT +90

MELODY +90

Pressing these buttons rotates a layer 90 degrees around the circle.
